Offered by the National Examination Board in Occupational Safety and Health (NEBOSH), it is designed for individuals responsible for ensuring workplace safety and managing risks, such as managers, supervisors, or anyone looking to pursue a career in health and safety.

Course Aim

The General National Certificate is aimed at individuals who need to gain a broad understanding of health and safety issues in the workplace.
